
Local COVID-19 Resources

Take a speed test to help define and advance broadband infrastructure improvements in Raymond and throughout Maine!

PROPERTY TAX EXEMPTIONS





Below is a list of property tax exemptions that may qualify you for a discount off your total assessed tax value.

★ HOMESTEAD EXEMPTION ★

This program provides a measure of property tax relief for certain individuals that have owned homestead property in Maine for at least 12 months and make the property they occupy on April 1 their permanent residence. Property owners would receive an exemption of up to \$25,000. For Fiscal Year 2021-2022 the state of Maine certified Raymond at 92% ratio so residents receive a \$23,000 (92% of \$25,000) exemption. Amount varies year to year.

★ VETERAN'S EXEMPTION ★

A veteran who served during a recognized war period and is 62 years or older; or, is receiving 100% disability as a Veteran; or became 100% disabled while serving, is eligible for \$6,000; A paraplegic veteran who received a federal grant for a specially adapted housing unit may receive \$50,000.

Veteran must be listed as a co-owner on the deed.

★ BLIND EXEMPTION ★

An individual who is determined to be legally blind receives \$4,000. Individual must be listed as a co-owner on the deed.
