MASK & BUILDING COVID-19 UPDATED POLICIES

**Fully vaccinated means the person has received the full dose of their recommended vaccine (1 or 2 doses) and has met the immunity guideline time frame after receiving their final dose.*

EFFECTIVE JUNE 1, 2021, THE TOWN OF RAYMOND MADE THE FOLLOWING POLICY CHANGES:

- Fully vaccinated* visitors and employees in town properties and buildings will no longer have to wear a face covering.
- Unvaccinated employees and visitors or those not yet fully vaccinated must continue to wear face coverings when in public buildings.
- Due to the increase in indoor capacity limits we are also no longer requiring that you call the office once in the parking lot to wait your turn. You may come right in.
